



TCAL Swim Meet rules are governed by the most recent Official Swimming Plan released from UIL along with the current versions of TCAL Constitution, Bylaws and Athletic Plan. Rules noted in this Swimming Plan supersede general athletic plan rules.

DIVISIONS. There shall be one division for high school boys and one division for high school girls.

ENTRIES. Girls', Boys' Team Restrictions – no girls' team shall compete against a boys' team and vice versa. In relay events, qualification is by school. One athlete can enter up to four individual races and two relays.

SUBSTITUTION IN INDIVIDUAL EVENTS. After the entry deadline, there shall be no substitutions allowed in the individual events according to National Federation High School Rules.

NUMBER OF MEETS. No student representing a participant school shall participate in more than seven meets during the school year, excluding the State Meet. Each meet a school team enters counts as one meet for each participating individual. Students are considered to be representing their school if they are wearing and/or using school equipment or being directed or transported by a school employee. No student representing a participant school shall participate in more than one meet per school.

TIMING. Swimmers shall be electronically timed unless the League office grants an exception.
